Love Made New Overcoming the World 1 John 5:1-5 September 11

<u>1</u>Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him. <u>2</u>By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. <u>3</u>For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. <u>4</u>For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. <u>5</u>Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

We Must Be Born Again

- 1. Discuss the exclusivity of Christ (Jesus is the only way to salvation) and why John keeps returning to it? Use 1 John 5:1 as a guide.
- 2. Discuss what it means to be "born again." How is a person born again? Use 1 John 5:1, Acts 4:10-12, John 3:3, John 14:6, and Matthew 7:21-23 as guides.
- 3. Have you been born again? Briefly share your testimony.

Obedience Brings Life and Peace

- 4. Discuss what the commandments of God reveal about God Himself. Use 1 John 5:2-3 as a guide.
- 5. Discus why the love of God and the love of neighbor cannot be separated.
- 6. Discuss what it means when John says "and his commandments are not burdensome." Use Matthew 11:28-30 as a guide. What does it mean if our religious practice become burdensome?

Live in Victory

- 7. Discuss the victory that Christ won over the world. What did He overcome? Use John 16:33 as a guide.
- 8. Thinking of the victory Christ won, what does overcoming the world look like for a Christian? Use 1 John 4:4 and 5:4-5 as guides.
