Seek What is Higher

- 1. Reflect on the idea that seeking the things above requires a continual choice. How can individuals cultivate a mindset that prioritizes eternal values over temporal ones?
- 2. Discuss what it means that our life is "hidden with Christ in God." How does this affect how we "seek the things that are above?"
- 3. Discuss what it means to "die to the elemental spirits of the world" in Colossians 2:20-23. Discuss the qualitative difference between the things above and the elemental spirits of the world.

Be Killing Sin or Sin will be Killing You – Verses 5-11

- 4. In what ways can putting to death "earthly desires" lead to a more fulfilling spiritual life?
- 5. Reflecting on the list of earthly sins mentioned, how do they manifest in modern society, and how do we "put to death" our connection to them? Use Colossians 3:5-11
- 6. Discuss how fleshly desires, worldly division, and cultural identity hinder our ability to "put on the new self." Use Colossians 3:5-11

- 7. Contrast the list of sins in Colossians 3:5-11 and the virtues listen in Colossians 3:12-17. Why must we die to one in order to pursue the other?
- 8. How does the idea of "letting" God work in our lives challenge common misconceptions about self-reliance and personal achievement?
- 9. Reflect on the call to do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus. How does this perspective shift our approach to daily tasks and interactions?
